



Cobblestone Vineyards

From his humble beginnings on a Michigan farm, Saul Levine became an FM radio pioneer in 1959 launching Mt. Wilson FM Broadcasters in Southern California. Levine's radio success helped him get back to his roots, and with his wife Anita he started Cobblestone Vineyards. For over 30 years Cobblestone only grew grapes for premium California wineries, until 2004 when the Levines released their own wines under the Cobblestone label.

The First Cobblestone estate began in 1972, in Monterey County. This Vineyard has grown to 50 acres and is planted to Chardonnay. In 1997, they purchased 25 acres high in the slopes of Atlas Peak North East of the town of Napa. This Vineyard led to their very first commercial release of Cabernet Sauvignon in 2001. Their recent purchased of a exceptional property along Te Mina Road, an especially remarkable terrace in the celebrated Pinot Noir village of Martinborough, New Zealand.

Concord Wines

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Kokomo winery started in 2004, located at scenic Timber Crest Farms in Healdsburg California. It started with the production of a single vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon. It focus on Dry Creek Russian Valley & Sonoma Coast fruit with an emphasis on single vineyard wines that show a distinct terroir. They believe that their small production techniques and relationships with growers allow them to make wines that are individuals and unique.



In January 2008, they celebrated the opening of their Brand new winery Timber Crest Farms a beautiful 120 acre vineyards Dry Creek Valley, with an incorporated tasting room into their cellar visitors can enjoy a unique wine tasting experience of variety of Cabernet Sauvignon Zinfandel and Sauvignon Blanc.

Erik Miller Winemaker and owner

Erik Miller has always had a ambition to make wines, after graduating from Purdue University he had his first opportunity to make an impression as a wine professional Winery in the Russian River Valley. Starting at ground level as a cellar worker, there was an immediate connection to the industry.

Erik began Kokomo Winery in 2004. In 2005 Erik brought on his best friend and college roommate Josh Bartels, to assist with the new winery's second vintage. With Josh on board the two upped production and increased the product line. After the 2006 harvest, Kokomo Winery moved into its own facility at Timber Crest Farms in Dry Creek Valley.

The Wines



Kokomo Sonoma County Zinfandel 2007

This is an elegant blend of 3 very unique Sonoma County vineyards. It is big and jammy with upfront aromas of black cherry and spice. It shows hints of blackberry while the finish is of dark chocolate and nice acidity. This multidimensional wine shows big fruit, but is balanced by earth overtones and brambly spice.

Great by itself, but it pairs well with almost anything off the grill and shortbread with cream for dessert.

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Mantra Winery

Mike and Lorene Kuimelis have been growing reserve designate grapes for noted wineries in the Alexander and Dry Creek Valleys of Sonoma County since the late 70's with roughly eighty acres under vine. The origin of Mantra Wines began with a single barrel of wine made by Mike Jr. in a garage from Mike Sr.'s grapes – one barrel led to two barrels and so forth until the popularity of the wine outpaced its production. True to their roots Mantra remain a boutique winery that produces hand-crafted wines of limited production levels Mantra is dedicated to producing wines that reflect the unique characteristics of their high elevation vineyard sites in the Alexander and Dry Creek Valleys of Sonoma County. They specialize in Cabernet Sauvignon, Zinfandel and Syrah



The wines



Mantra Alexander Valley Reserve Old Vines Zinfandel 2006 HK\$268/Btl

This wine is a raspberry/chocolate bomb! The fruit comes from our , old-vine high elevation vineyard in Cloverdale. An extended cold soak and natural fermentation were used in small open top fermenters and then aged in Hungarian, French and American cooperage. The aromas of this wine jump out of the glass and evolve. Ripe dark fruits give way to raspberry, blackberry cherry, chocolate and black pepper finishing with aromas of lavender, dried rose petals and spice. This is a rich and concentrated wine brimming with juicy flavors of briar fruits with clean acidity and a lengthy finish.

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PRIEST RANCH

Priest Ranch Wines represent the distinctiveness of the Somerston property located 8 miles due east of Rutherford in the rugged Valley region of eastern Napa Valley, with an intensely rich yet approachable quality. The name Priest Ranch is a tribute to the historical name associated with part of the property. It was originally settled by James Joshua Priest in 1847 and was known as the Priest Ranch for over a hundred years.

The diverse terrain features a wide range of valley, hillside and mountain top sites. Each block is based on the interplay between soil, pitch, sun exposure and air flow. We produce wines that pay respect to their varietal composition and the intricacies of terroir. They are deep, rich, lush and complex. All of our bottling drink well in their youth, but possess the intensity and balance and tannin structure to guarantee longevity.

Winery and Winemaking Philosophy

Each of our wines has its own remarkable way of expressing the hillsides and mountain tops it is from. We believe that great wines are a reflection of their place – the combination of soil, topography, microclimate and people – and we believe that quality grapes handled with minimal processing have the potential to produce the greatest wines. *Craig Becker*, our winemaker feels that blending is the key to crafting the most complete, balanced wine and enhancing the inherent characteristics of each variety. The ultimate goal is the creation of a rich, seamless wine.



Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley 2007

The 2007 Priest Ranch Cabernet Sauvignon shows enticing aromas of black cherry, raspberry, vanilla and cedar. The mouth feel is dense and focused with fine tannins and a long finish. Our favorite food pairing is Lamb burgers with avocado and fresh ground mustard on a brioche bun.

We Fly Wherever

At Highflyer, we work with small, family-owned, benchmark vineyards throughout California where terroir and variety are in perfect alignment. Family-Owned Vineyards

Centerline is a proprietary red blend of Syrah, Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, Tempranillo, and Grenache. Napa Valley's "Somerston Vineyards"- located 8 miles due east of Rutherford in the rugged Elder Valley region of eastern Napa Valley, makes up 92% of the blend while adding a dash of Bennett Valley's "Vivio Vineyard"- located in northern part of the Sonoma Valley, Syrah 8% gave us unique spicy backbone to the wine.



By combining fruit from these two distinct climates we were able to produce a wine that is remarkably distinctive, complex, balanced and compelling.
